
IYCF-E GLOBAL CAPACITY STRENGTHENING AND INNOVATIONS GRANT



Project Overview (July 2016 – July 2018)

Project Goal: Global capacity is strengthened and evidence is built for quality interventions in Infant and Young Child Feeding in Emergencies (IYCF-E)

Project Justification: Optimal breastfeeding and complementary feeding could reduce child mortality in children under five more than any other preventative measure; however, translating this knowledge into practice has been challenging largely due to a lack of IYCF-E capacity on the ground and a lack of evidence to support implementation of IYCF-E interventions.
