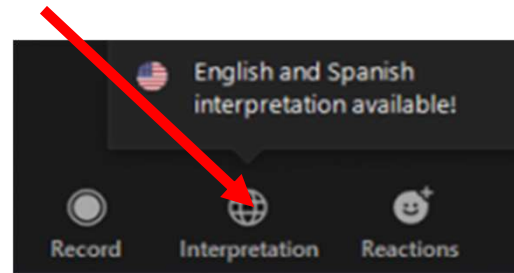

-  Evolved from the Global Technical Assistance Mechanism (2017–2020)
-  13 organizations working directly, 40 staff = 13 full time people
-  Co-led by UNICEF-PG and Save the Children, supported by Leadership Team

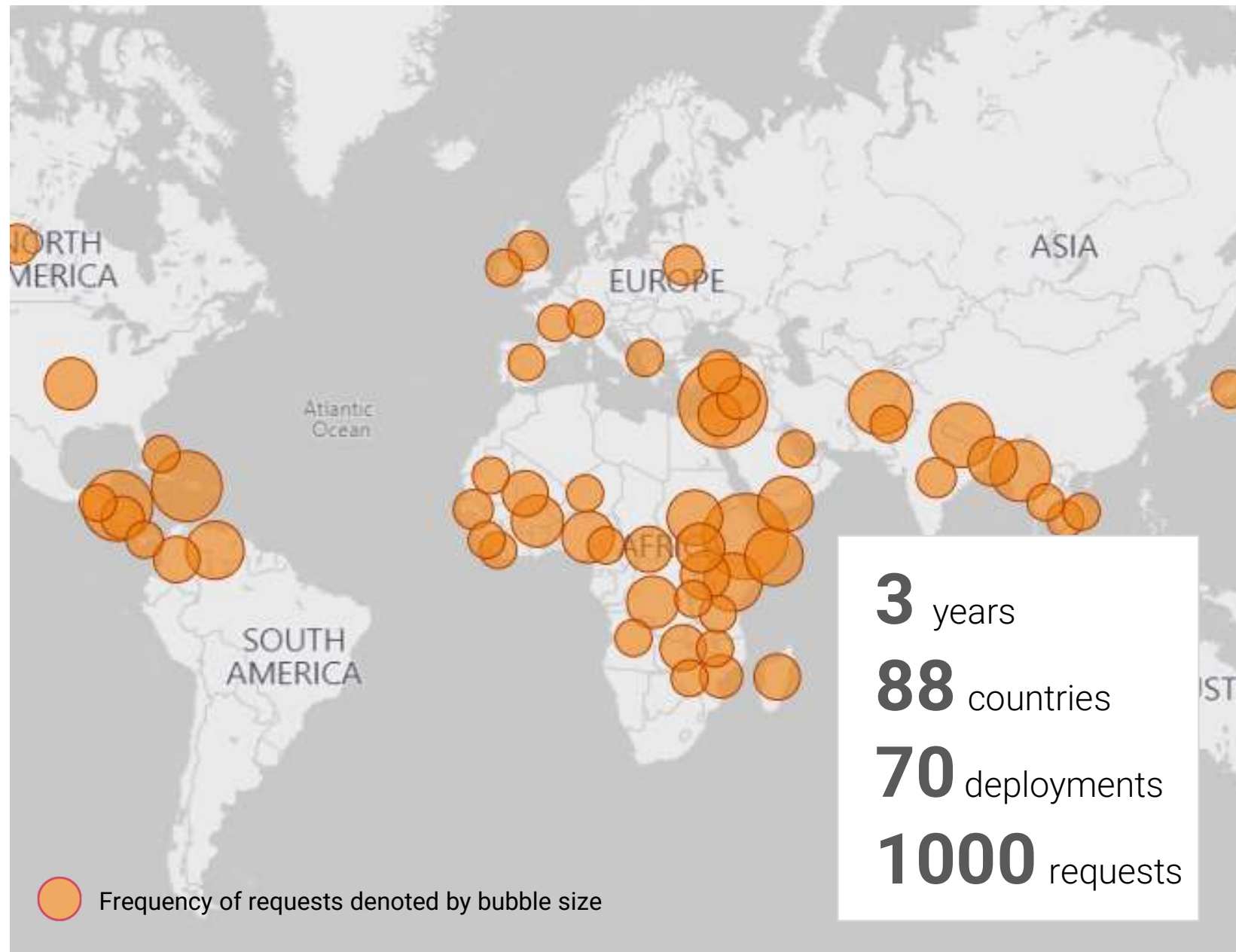

Evaluation Findings

-  Alliance's services were mostly relevant and effective in responding to needs of practitioners
-  Structure was mostly useful, but gaps exist
-  Within the NiE community, there is consensus that awareness of the Alliance is low.
-  Clear anecdotal evidence of the impact that the Alliance can have on practitioners

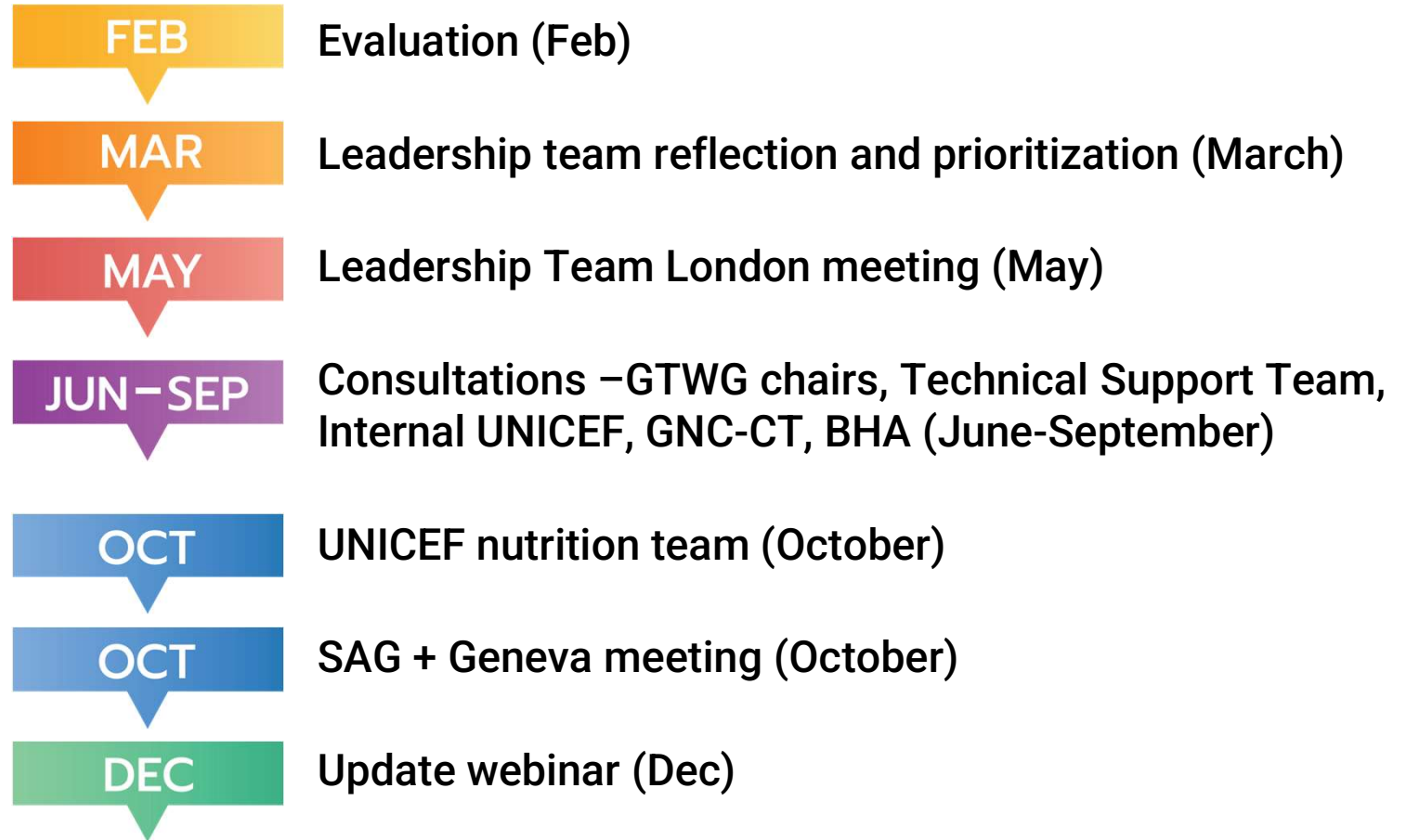

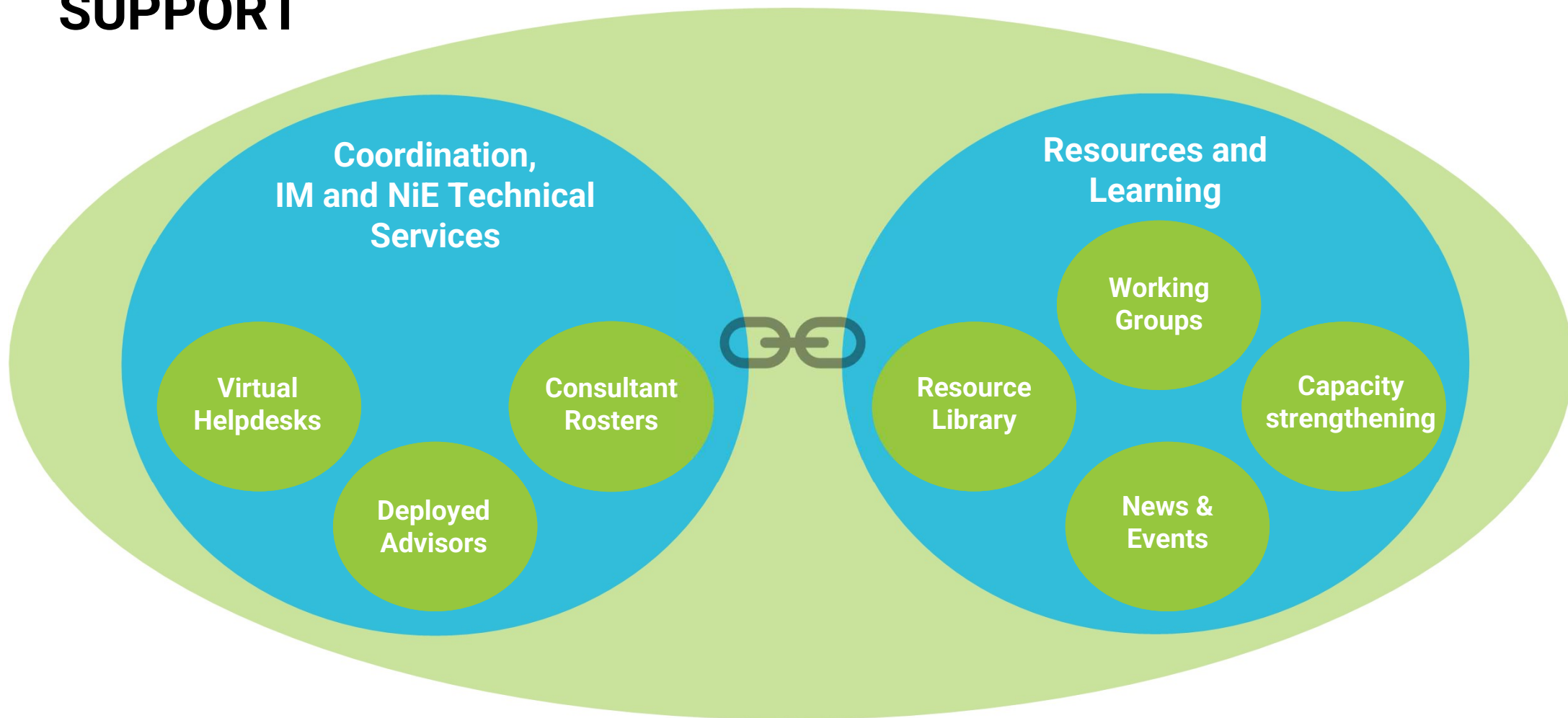
